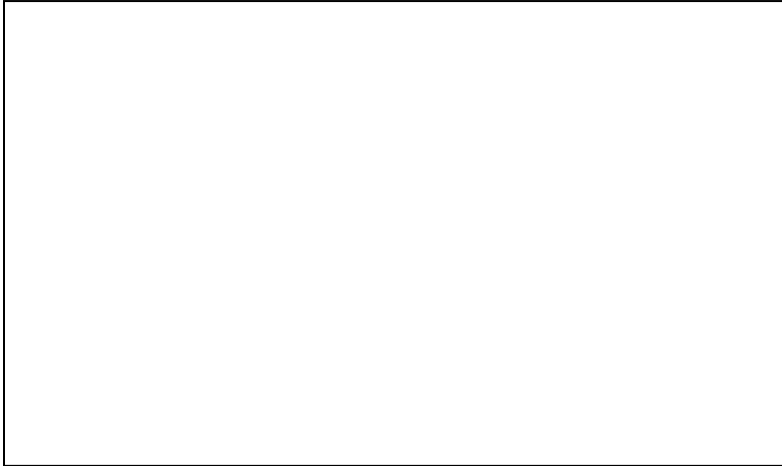


Exam review

Contour Line Drawing of your shoe, hand, or small 3-D object- remember to use many different kinds of lines.



Value Scale – draw a 7 step scale labeled in modeling – show example of medium value in crosshatching, stipple and scumbling too

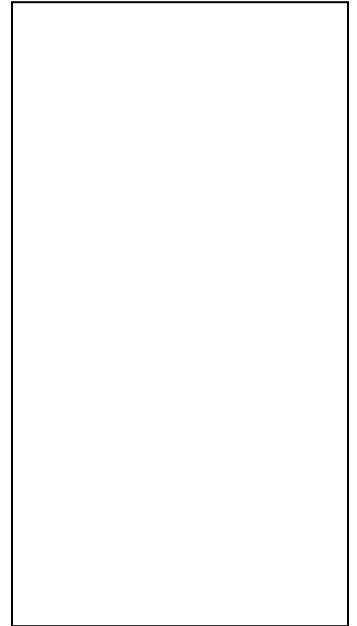
Value Scale in Color: use colored pencil, make it 7 steps and label it- make sure you add black to achieve a low value

Neutral scale in Color (use paint, make it 7 steps and label it

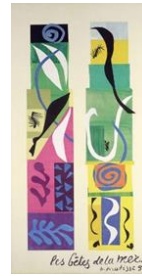
Color transition from yellow to magenta/red- use media of your choice, make it 7 steps and orange is in the middle

Choose one artwork to copy on the back in your choice of media, pay attention to how you apply the medium to ensure the message stays the same



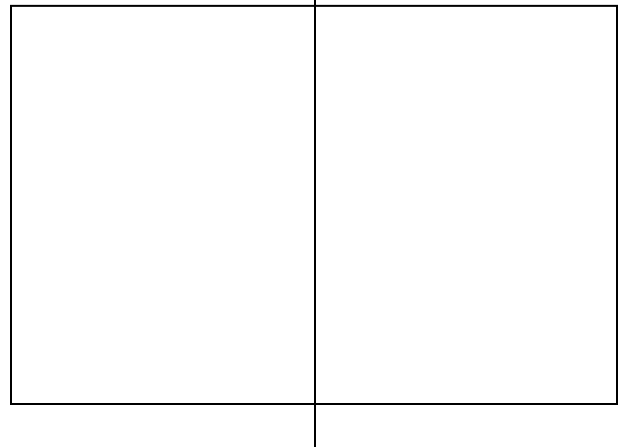
For the work you chose to re-create, what medium did you choose and why?

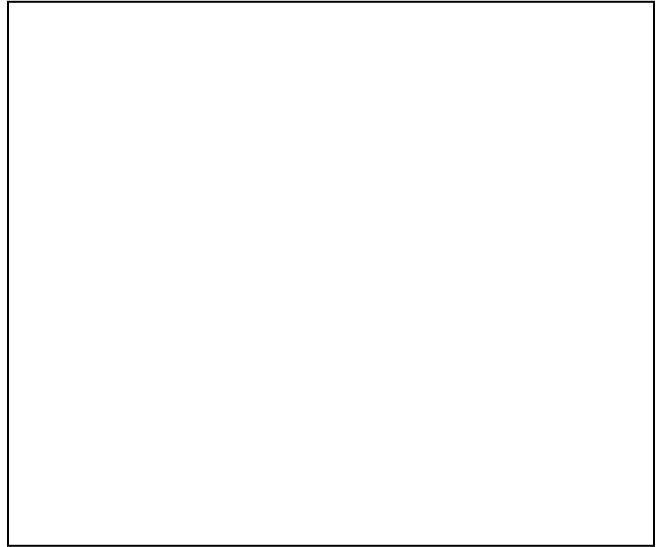

Draw a grid over the image & enlarge it in the space provided next to the photo.

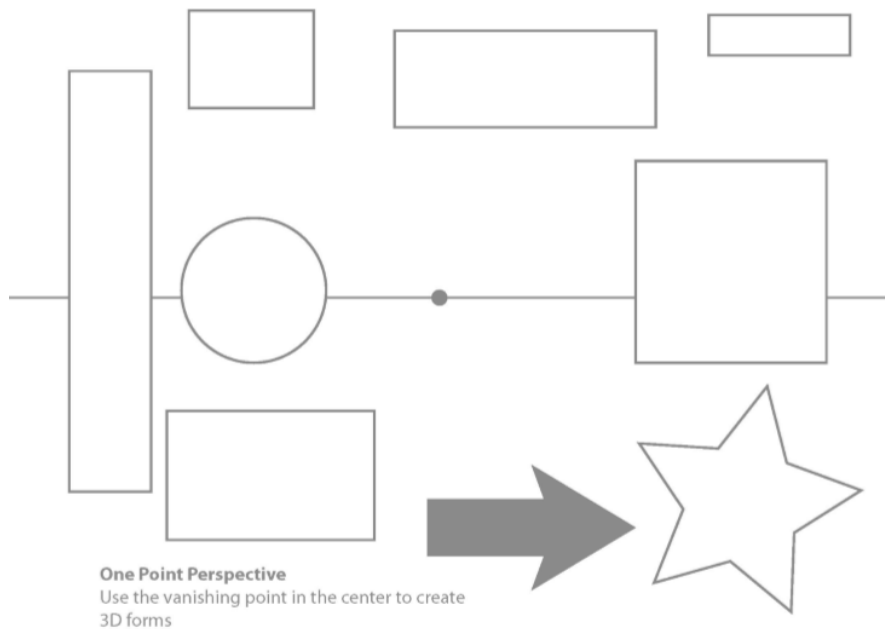
