- 6- Reflect on exploring color by journaling on this page in your sketchbook. Leave room to glue a few photos of the work onto this page. Note what you learned in your team, by observing other teams, by collaborating beyond your team, by what you thought was "creative" versus what other teams/team members thought was "creative."
