Studio Activity: Faces and Family


Drawing the human face takes patience

 - c. Mouth
 - d. Ear
 - e. Whole face- Profile view
 - f. Whole face- frontal view
 - g. Whole face- 34 view
- 2- Cut them out/print them out and glue into sketchbook
- 3- Use these images as your reference images for the "Feature" areas in the 1 x 1's

3 symbols of "Family" (according to you), 2 colors that best define your family or a family tradition, a pattern that a family member wears often, food your family makes at celebrations, sports you play as a family, what you are thankful for, caricatures of your family members, etc
