Final Projects menu

Student will:

- 1- Select TWO projects to complete on or before January 13th
- 2- Each project includes
 - a. A blog
 - b. 2+ pages of work in sketchbook
 - i. Reference images (2+)
 - ii. Research sources
 - iii. Thumbnail sketches/plans for more than one way to solve problem
 - iv. Media/methods trials
 - c. Focused attention on improving ONE art making skill for EACH project
 - i. You will document that in sketchbook for one
 - ii. The other will be used as a feature 1-2minute tutorial to embed into the blog
- 3- Each project will be a minimum of 11 x 14" and a maximum of 16 x 20" (except for option D which will be 15 x 21')
- 4- Each project has free choice of medium BUT may mean students provide some of their own supplies

Artistic Problems:

A- Rework Project 1 or make any of our small skills projects into a BIG project

This work will be bigger, better, more complex and visually appealing than the previous work – it will require a lot of "out of the box" thinking and research to elevate a "skill building" assignment into a full blown art work.

- B- Create an abstract self portrait that uses color to express meaning (This work needs to be based on a master artist, independent research must be done)
- C- Create a landscape from multiple sources that shows depth, has a full range of values AND has exceptional use of a value method in your choice of media
- D- Take a photo (subject of your choice) print it out at 5 x 7 size and recreate it 3 times larger using grid system of enlargement
